TERMS OF POSITION

- This position will be 6 months in duration
- Terms shall begin immediately after voting ends
- Role transition shall occur at the discretion of outgoing and incoming candidates

ELECTION PROCEDURES

- Applications will be sent directly to the Elections Officer
- Applications will be due on **January 21st, 2019 at 11:59PM EST**
- Applicants will be required to submit a cover letter and curriculum vitae to the Elections Officer. The Elections Officer will **remove all identifying information** to OMSA Council, who shall review each applicant
- Each member of the Electorate will have one ballot, and voting will be conducted online by a ranked ballot system, verified by the Elections Officer
- The Electorate will be the VP Externals at each school and the Executive Council, unless they are running in the election, in which case it will go to the Elections Officer.
- Nominees may withdraw their nomination at any time by writing to the Elections Officer.
- Election results will be communicated within one week of the voting period
